

# Yulyurlu Lorna Fencer Napurrurla

## Activities

### PRE SCHOOL / LOWER PRIMARY

#### *Pre-visit activities*

Pre-visit activities are designed to inform students about *Yulyurlu Lorna Fencer Napurrurla* and assist them interpret and understand what they will see at the exhibition.

- Read stories about Aboriginal myths and culture
- Talk about visiting the gallery and what they will see
- Show pictures of how plants grow, talk about vegetables that grow underground

#### *At the exhibition*

Gallery activities are based around Children's Labels which are located at points around the exhibition

- Organise the students into small groups with a leader
- Look at the works and read out the Children's Labels
- Encourage students to talk and share ideas about what they are seeing and hearing

#### Post visit activities



- 1 Make small animals and plants from plasticine or modeling clay. Place the plants and animals into a bush scene with small branches for trees and stones and pebbles and sand for hills, rocks and ground. Give the plants and animals names. Make up a story about the place.
- 2 Look at the patterns in nature. Show how plants divide in repeating patterns. Make potato and other vegetable stamps to make a painting where the lines keep dividing like a tree. (See upper primary activity).
- 3 Cook some sweet potato for morning tea.
